

# Grace Notes



2022

The month of February is well-known for the observance of Valentine's Day on February 14. In addition to taking the time to learn more about the historical St. Valentine, this provides us the opportunity to see how the Psalms teach us to pray in light of God's love for us. The place to turn is Psalm 136. Start by pausing your reading right here, pray all of Psalm 136, and then come back to consider this Word of God in greater detail.

I imagine it didn't take you long to see why we're looking at this Psalm as we think about God's love; the refrain in the second part of each verse goes like this: "for His steadfast love endures forever." It's easy to imagine this Psalm being used in the worship life of God's Old Testament people. I can hear the priest speaking the first line of each verse and the congregation responding with that beautiful refrain each time. We do well to use this Psalm similarly in our own worship here at Grace and in our devotions at home; you might consider praying Psalm 136 together as a family, with one family member speaking the first part of each verse and the rest of the family speaking the refrain together.

The Hebrew word *chesed*, which is translated "steadfast love" in the English Standard Version, is a rich word that carries a depth of meaning. The word is used 125 times in the Psalter as the most common way that the psalmists talk about God's grace. God's *chesed* is His faithfulness to the promise He made to His people Israel, even when they have been unfaithful. God's *chesed* is His loyalty to His people even when they have been disloyal. God's *chesed* is His unwavering commitment to bring salvation to His people by sending His Son to live, die, and rise. God's *chesed* is His goodness in action to bless His people with life, forgiveness, and salvation apart from any merit or worthiness in us.

Psalm 136 praises God by recounting the history of how God has shown His steadfast love to His people. Psalm 136:1-3 introduces the prayer through Trinitarian praise. In vv.4-10, God's steadfast love is seen in His works of creation. In vv.10-16, God's steadfast love is seen in the rescue He gave to His people from slavery in Egypt. In vv.17-22, God's steadfast love is seen in His gift of the Promised Land

to Israel by the conquest of Canaan. In vv.23-25, God's steadfast love is seen in His continued care for Israel in the present and into the future. The final verse of the Psalm summarizes everything that came before: "Give thanks to the God of heaven, for his steadfast love endures forever."

No wonder Psalm 136 teaches us to give thanks to the LORD for His steadfast love that endures forever! We are invited to pray with confidence that God has shown steadfast love to us in the past, that He is showering steadfast love upon us now, and that He will never fail to give steadfast love in the future. The word "love" in our culture is often reduced to a feeling that is here today and gone tomorrow, but this is a far cry from the reality of God's steadfast love. God's steadfast love is no mere feeling that one day will be gone. God's steadfast love is His faithfulness, loyalty, and commitment to give to us all that we need for this life and the next. Making this all the more astounding, steadfast love is the way God acts toward us even though we have surely deserved nothing but punishment. God's steadfast love is seen most clearly in the event to which Psalm 136 looks forward: the life, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus. Completely by His grace, God has given His Son to save us sinners. That's the steadfast love of God in action to the fullest.

Psalm 136 is a beautiful text to have in our minds as our world thinks about "love" on Valentine's Day. Here God gives us a true picture of what love is—His commitment to bring salvation to us sinners. God grant that we would share the good news of His love with our family, friends, and neighbors this February and always!


### Family Sunday School

### Hope of Christ for Cancer Patients — \$70,000

*As Christians, we are charged with sharing the message of the Gospel and the Word with all individuals. The mission of Phil's Friends, an LCMS Recognized Service Organization, is to introduce and strengthen relationships with Christ by providing faith-based hope to those with cancer. The support includes a care package with practical, emotional, and spiritual items, including a Bible, a card sent monthly for 12 months, and a new program "Hope on Call," in which Phil's Friends' trained volunteers meet virtually with the cancer patient to talk and pray. This grant would further fund Phil's Friends Cancer Care Packages, Cards of Hope, and Hope on Call.*
