

# Grace Notes



The month of January provides several opportunities for Christians to give thanks to God for the lives of His people throughout the ages. It is a New Year, but the Lord's blessings still come to us in His Holy Word, as they always have. I'll highlight three important celebrations of the Church Year during the month of the January that will help you stay grounded in His Word.

On January 1, the Church celebrates the Circumcision and Name of Jesus. This account is given in Luke 2:21, "And at the end of eight days, when He was circumcised, He was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb." Already as an eight-day old boy, Jesus fulfills the Law in the place of sinners (Galatians 4:4-7). As He does so, He sheds His blood. This is the first, but not the last, time that Jesus does this for sinners. In shedding His blood in the place of sinners, Jesus rightly receives His name, for He is the One to save us from our sins (Matthew 1:21). Because Jesus has fulfilled the Law perfectly and shed His blood in our place, we are saved by His grace through faith in Him. His righteousness covers us perfectly, not by circumcision, but by the washing of water and Word in Holy Baptism (Colossians 2:11). On January 1, begin the New Year by giving thanks for the name of Jesus that has been placed upon you in Holy Baptism.

On January 6, the Church observes the Epiphany of Our Lord. The word "epiphany" means "revealing." On this day, we remember how Jesus was revealed as the Savior for all nations when the Magi visited Him with their gifts. Jesus is not only the "King of the Jews" (Matthew 2:2); He is the King over all (Matthew 28:18). These most unlikely visitors learned from God's Word (Matthew 2:5-6) and the guiding of the Lord's star (Matthew 2:9) that the Savior had been born for them in Bethlehem, and so they went to worship Him with

great joy. On January 6, read Matthew 2:1-12 and give thanks that God has revealed Jesus to be your Savior as you go to worship Him with great joy every week in the Divine Service.

On January 18, the Church gives thanks for the Confession of St. Peter. Jesus asked His apostles the question about Himself that all people finally must answer: "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). Simon Peter answered for the whole group: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16). This was not born out of Peter's own imagination; God the Father had brought about this faith. This faith, this confession, is the rock upon which Jesus builds His Church. Not even hell can stand against this faith, for this faith rests upon Jesus alone. All who confess this faith find an open heaven, but all who deny this faith find eternal life locked to them. On January 18, read Matthew 16:13-19, give thanks to God that He has given you the same trust as St. Peter, and pray for opportunities to confess that faith boldly before the world.

This month also includes a notable string of three consecutive days in which we give thanks for St. Timothy, Pastor and Confessor (January 24; read 1 Timothy 6:11-16), the Conversion of St. Paul (January 25; read Acts 9:1-22), and St. Titus, Pastor and Confessor (January 26; read Titus 1:1-9). During this New Year, ask the Lord for strength to continue more steadfastly in hearing and reading His Word, not just on Sunday mornings, but throughout the week. I pray that the Lord richly blesses you through the accounts and examples of His faithful saints, men and women whom He has forgiven by His blood.


The store is closed from December 22 to January 6. No donations accepted



**National Mission Grant Bulletin Bytes:**

**Mobile Medical Mercy Mission Bus for Guatemala (\$100,000)**

While Guatemala is a beautiful country, many people suffer in extreme poverty. Over 50% of the children are malnourished and have no access to any form of medical or dental care. Most have no pre-natal or post-natal care and often die from preventable diseases. Immanuel Lutheran Church, Hood River, Oregon and the Lutheran Church of Guatemala have partnered together to share God’s physical and spiritual healing with as many souls as possible. They have developed a network of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod partner churches to send medical professionals and mission teams to Guatemala on short term medical mission trips. In order to reach these isolated villages they need the right tool, namely a Mobile Medical Mercy Mission Bus. The funds will be used to purchase and retrofit a bus with medical equipment. Bible school equipment will also be purchased enabling the teams to heal both the physical and spiritual needs of the Guatemalan children. While the physicians tend to their physical needs, the ministers and lay leaders go into the villages and set up bible classes, VBS and worship services. Child Beyond International will continue to financially support this ministry.
