Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! The celebration of Jesus' resurrection is once again here. What joy is ours to know, believe, and proclaim that sin is forgiven, the devil is crushed, and death has been put to death, all because Jesus has been raised from the dead. Easter is the most important event that has ever happened in human history. For these reasons, our celebration of Jesus' resurrection is not limited to one Sunday, but we dedicate an entire season to it. This month, let's take a look at the ways we continue to give thanks for Jesus' resurrection during this season of the Church Year.

During the season of Easter, we slow our celebration down to "real-time." God's Word teaches us that the time in between Jesus' resurrection and the day of Pentecost was fifty days—and that's how long the season of Easter lasts. During those fifty days, we hear several accounts from the Gospels that tell us how Jesus appeared bodily to His disciples on multiple occasions in order to teach them the Scriptures. For example, the 2nd Sunday of Easter always reminds us of Jesus' appearance to Thomas, who then confessed the truth about Jesus that we believe along with him: "My Lord and my God!" We also hear Gospel readings that include long sections of Jesus' teaching. For example, the 4th Sunday of Easter is Good Shepherd Sunday, when we use Psalm 23 for the Introit and hear Jesus tell us in John 10 how He has laid down His life for us. On the fortieth day of the season, we celebrate our Lord's ascension into heaven with a special evening worship service (that will take place on Thursday, May 30 this year). Much like the season of Christmas contains too much joy for one day, and so we celebrate for twelve days, the season of Easter contains so much joy that we celebrate for fifty days!

The season of Easter is also marked by singing—lots of it! The Lenten fast from certain expressions of praise is over. The fullness of resurrection joy resounds once again during the season of Easter, as we sing "Alleluia" every chance we get. We leave worship every week humming the hymn of praise, "This is the Feast." Many of the most joyful and comforting hymns of the church occur during the season of Easter: "Jesus Christ Is Risen Today," "I Know that My Redeemer Lives," "Awake, My Heart, with Gladness," and "Jesus Lives! The Victory's Won," to name just a few.

Finally, the season of Easter includes several especially beautiful adornments to our sanctuary. The Easter lilies trumpet the reminder of the resurrection life that is ours because Jesus has been raised from the dead. The paraments are white, the color of holiness, purity, and new life. Our banners show forth the light of resurrection, as the cross that for the world would be the sign of death has become for us faithful the sign of eternal life. The paschal candle is lit every Sunday during the season of Easter to recall that the light of Christ that shone forth for us on Easter morning now is given to us in the water and Word of Holy Baptism.

Jesus' death and resurrection have changed everything. Our salvation is accomplished. There is no doubt about it. This is the good news for all of us, and it is the good news for the world. How can we help but celebrate it for a full season? How can we help but proclaim it to everyone we meet, not only during this time of the year, but always? The fact is: we can't help it! Let's tell the news, dear members of Grace, that more may hear and believe. Alleluia! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!



(\$36,500)

One of the largest needs in Prison and Jail Ministry is not only the offering of Word and Sacrament ministry to those incarcerated, but also in assisting the person when he or she returns to the community. The Prison and Jail Ministry Conference enables over 200 lay and clergy participants from 30 of our LCMS districts to learn about the importance of prison and jail ministry as well as networking with one another for best practices and support of each other in a very difficult mission and ministry. A number of LCMS districts are already doing, or are starting up a Prison and Jail Ministry, and a Synod-wide conference will allow these to continue and expand as changes and new developments continue in the federal and state criminal justice systems. Grant funds would help pay for the expenses involved in hosting a conference.


