

# Grace Notes



2022

Our hymn of the month for October is *LSB* #655, "Lord, Keep Us Steadfast in Your Word." This hymn is not only well-known to our congregation; it has been sung in the Church for almost five hundred years. Martin Luther wrote the text of the hymn, which was first published in 1542. The hymn serves as a prayer that God would help us to remain faithful to Him and to His Word no matter what attacks may come against us. For that reason, it has often been sung around the yearly remembrance of the Reformation, when God called His Church back to the truth that we are saved by grace alone through faith alone because of Christ alone. We'll take a look at the text of the hymn together in this article.

In the first stanza of the hymn, we sing: "Lord, keep us steadfast in Your Word; Curb those who by deceit or sword Would wrest the kingdom from Your Son And bring to naught all He has done." The initial prayer of the hymn is drawn from Psalm 119:5, "Oh that my ways may be steadfast in keeping your statutes!" Such a prayer is necessary because the devil, the world, and our own sinful nature are constantly attacking us, whether by lies or by force. In this stanza, we ask God for the same thing that we do in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Petition of the Lord's Prayer: that God would hinder the attacks of our enemies so that His will of keeping us as members of His Church would be done.

In the second stanza, we sing: "Lord Jesus Christ, Your power make known, For You are Lord of lords alone; Defend Your holy Church that we May sing Your praise eternally." This stanza calls upon Jesus as the Ascended Lord of His Church. Jesus promised in Matthew 28:18, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Jesus uses His almighty authority to protect His Church and to work all things for the good of His people (Romans 8:28). Not even the gates of hell will prevail against the Church (Matthew 16:16) because Jesus is her defender. As a result, we sing the praises of our Savior: "I will sing to the LORD, because he has dealt bountifully with me" (Psalm 13:6).

In the third stanza, we sing: "O Comforter of priceless worth, Send peace and unity on earth; Support us in our final strife And lead us out of death to life." This stanza is a prayer to the Holy Spirit. He is the Comforter or Counselor or Helper who brings the Word of God to our remembrance so that we have the peace of Christ (John 14:26-27). We ask the Holy Spirit to do His work of calling, gathering, and uniting the Christian Church around Jesus: "There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all" (Ephesians 4:4-6). By the Word of God, the Holy Spirit sustains us in faithfulness to God's Word until the end, when we will be raised from the dead and dwell in body and soul for all eternity with Christ.

Though this hymn is short, both the text and the tune are powerful. As together we sing and pray this hymn, God grant that our faith in His Word increase, no matter what attacks we might endure, so that on the Last Day, we will be together with Him and the whole Church in the joys of resurrection!
